HOMOEOPATHY IN EMERGENCY

A well-known myth about Homoeopathic medicine is that they act slowly. So the severe acute cases like injuries haemorrhage, burns, shock and terminally ill patients rarely resort for Homoeopathic treatment. On the contrary Homoeopathy has tremendous scope in emergency cases and it acts faster than any other pathy. It not only heals up the disease condition but also improve the general health of the patients. Haemorrhage is one of the most urgent problems, which can endanger the patient's life if not treated in time. It can be internal or external.

Factors, which can lead to bleeding as follows-

- Injury – Accident, blow, falls and cut.
- Uterine disorder in females- abortion, fibroids.
- Ovarian cyst, Dysfunctional uterine bleeding.
- Piles, fistula.
- Epistaxis (nose bleeding).
- Blood disorder like hemophilia.

Homoeopathic medicines stop the bleeding and the cures the underlying cause also.

*Cases:*

A 31 years old male patient reported on 10.09.2007. He was badly injured over the right eye with iron rod. His whole eye was swollen with the conjunctival haemorrhage. He was given one dose of ledum followed by arnica. Patient again reported on 12.09.2008. His swelling was remarkable reduced with slight improvement in conjunctival redness. He was given Merc cor for conjunctival haemorrhage followed by arnica after two days. On 17.09.07 his injured eye was completely normal.

A girl, 15 years of age reported for heavy, copious intermenstrual bleeding on 25.01.08. She was having right ovarian cyst with craving for chocolates. Based on these symptoms she was prescribed podophyllum. Her bleeding stopped within two days.

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
